HSAC ready for 2012

Hello Club Members ...

I am pleased to inform you that the club survived the Winter season after everything the weather could throw at us. With northerlies, ice and snow always ready to appear on Sundays members bravely fought through these conditions to record results with only one match cancelled and that was due to poor attendance rather than weather. The traditional New Year Open was for a change well attended with 42 anglers participating. The dabs and whiting were there in abundance with John Lacey from Gt. Yarmouth taking the match with 11lb 14oz from 38 fish. Top clubman was Stephen Boyce with 11lb 8oz from 42 fish. Subsequent club matches saw catches decline slightly as the weather closed in with one match re-ording just 4 fish in a strong northerly. The Team Challenge and Winter Open saw a poor turn out in a stiff northerly but fish were found with the Team event resulting in a perfect draw between a club team and Police X. The Open was also a tie between Bill Beeton and Dene Conway with 1lb 8oz from 10 and 7 fish respectively.


The Winter Accumulator was taken by Tony Thomas with an aggregate weight total of 19lb 5oz. Tony also took the overall league for the year with 398 points from Dene with 378 points and Sam Attew with 315 points.

The season ended with the Presentation Dinner and AGM at Kelling Heath Holiday Park on 18th March. At this members and guests indulged themselves to an excellent meal and service which was followed by the presentation of the season's trophies. The dinner was preceded by the AGM where a number of club matters were discussed and agreed. The following briefly details these ...

- The new committee for 2012-2013 was elected as identified below with Henry Randell to be co-opted on 4th May 2012.
- The club made a slight profit for last year so membership fees remain unchanged.
- A new clause will be introduced into the club's constitution at the next AGM to address cheating in club matches whereby a life ban will be effective.
- Size limits for the year remain unchanged from previous season.
- The committee will investigate venues between Trimmingham and Gt. Yarmouth when catches are poor on the shingle ridge.
- The club will run a West Norfolk Challenge series of 4 matches in the river Ouse at Kings Lynn between May and September.
- The club will run a North Norfolk (teams) Sea League this Autumn/Winter which will either replace or complement the existing North Norfolk Sea League.
- The fixtures for the Summer were agreed and are detailed in this newsletter.
- Slight modifications were made to the club match rules to bring them in line with SAMF rules as well as adding a new rule to handle match cheating.
- All monies won at each club match will now be retained by the club and presented at the Presentation Evening at the end of the season.

This was a constructive meeting preparing us for the season ahead and enabling us to build on the success of the past few months. Hopefully we will see more Ladies and some Juniors joining us this year. Looking forward to seeing you for the first match of the new season at Salthouse on Sunday 15th April 2012 fishing 10 to 3.
